Secondly, teens experience first hand that our choices create our consequences, in turn, our lives. With these two premises in mind, and through many varied learning processes, teens practice skills to make conscious choices. They practice personal authority, self-discipline and self-trust.

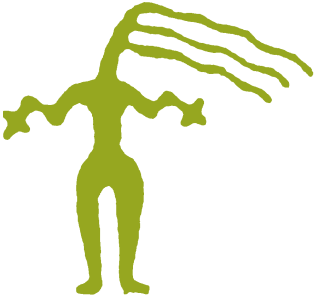
TRUE COLORS is made up of teens from diverse backgrounds who want solid relationships with their family, friends and themselves.

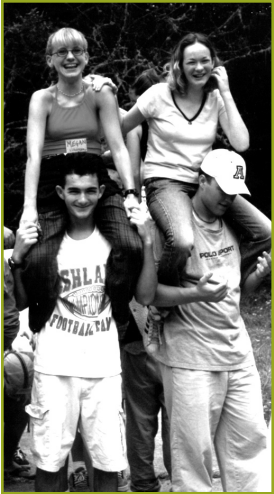

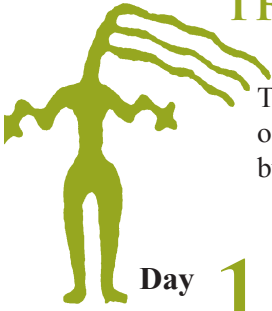
TRUE COLORS PURPOSES

LOST VALLEY EDUCATIONAL CENTER

Lost Valley Educational Center is an intentional living community and nonprofit center located on eighty-seven beautiful acres in the foothills of the Cascades, eighteen miles southeast of Eugene, Oregon. The center includes forest, meadow, gardens, a creek and a 45-acre recovering forest. The center is committed to stewarding the land and developing a sustainable culture.

Teens at Lost Valley stay in one of the two rustic dormitories, which are nestled in the woods among Douglas fir trees. Each dormitory has a full bathroom on each floor. Each dorm room has two bunk beds, accommodating up to four people. Other groups may be staying at Lost Valley while teens are there.

The food service at Lost Valley is known for its tasty and abundant ORGANIC VEGETARIAN cuisine, cooked and served in an atmosphere of loving and caring service. Community grace is often said before meals. Commitment to the health of residents, visitors and the planet is apparent through the food served, which is grown organically, bioregionally and locally whenever possible.
